### APPLICATION PROCESS

### WHO IS ELIGIBLE TO APPLY

- A. Current North Dakota Farmers Union members, members of a cooperative or relatives of past Co-op House member.
- B. Applicants must plan to enroll as a **freshman** at **North Dakota State University**.

### HOW TO ESTABLISH ACADEMIC ACHIEVEMENT

Attach your most recent high school transcript. Also include a copy of your ACT scores as they are important to the selection process.

- Applicants need to be pursuing a career important to rural America. However, the field of study is not limited to agri-business, farm operation and production agriculture.
- During the last three years of school, applicants must have a grade point average (GPA) of at least 2.5 on a 4.0 scale.
